



The National Veterans Memorial and Museum (NVMM) is the first monument or museum where Americans from all over the country can celebrate and honour their war veterans. APA Facade System provided our system partners Flynn Group of Companies with our complete package, including fabrication of our facade systems, logistics management and a design assist service throughout the project.

The challenge APA's design team faced, was to integrate full height curtain wall screens into a building where substantial parts of the curtain walling was obscured by the concrete façade, making it impossible to glaze in a traditional manner. This meant every one of the 230 mullions, some of which were 12.5 metres high unsupported, were unique. This bespoke curtain wall system was required to follow the flowing curved form surrounding the entirety of the NVMM building. Glazing works on this project surpassed \$10 million
