



The Human Biology Building at the National University of Ireland, Galway is the new home for the School of Medicine, providing teaching and research facilities for undergraduate and postgraduate students. This five-storey building will accommodate the disciplines of Anatomy, Pharmacology, Therapeutics and Physiology.

It is a four-storey building over basement with a roof top plant enclosure and gross floor area of 8,200 sq.m.
