The Mercer Institute for Successful Ageing (MISA) is an innovative healthcare facility in the southeast corner of St. James's Hospital in Dublin City.

This seven-storey, 15,000m², state of the art building provides a centralised facility for the institute's clinical, education and training, research and creative life work with older people.

It includes research facilities, consultation spaces, meeting spaces, catering facilities, day areas, roof terrace spaces, a courtyard a naturally lit foyer and conference rooms. It has 76 en suite bedrooms with further ward spaces to accommodate a total of 100 beds.

Mercer Institute for Successful Aging features APA's thermally enhanced ST70 Hi windows and doors, alongside our TB50 curtain wall system.

MISA won the "Best Health Building" at the Royal Institute of Architecture (RIAI) Awards in 2017. The project was also shortlisted for the Public Choice Award.
