



This project at Colliers Wood Tower or Brittania Point as it's now known involved the partial demolition and structural alterations to an existing tower block and the construction of a new six storey concrete framed extension to the north of the tower. The development consists of 182 apartments, ground floor retail units and extensive landscaping works.

Before the complete transformation by KDS & Associates Limited it was named "London's Ugliest Building" in a BBC poll.

APA Facade System's TB60 SG curtain wall and ST70 window and door systems surround this 35,000 sq. metre building, installed by Season Master Double Glazing Ltd.
