

Kevin Street Garda Headquarters

Dublin



Kevin Street Garda Station is the Divisional Headquarters for the south inner city and was designed by the OPW as a civic quality building responding to the specific site context and its historic surroundings. The new building extends to 6,840m² of office space with a 5,400m² double basement and is an impressively engineered concrete framed structure, which cantilevers over Bride Street and has a 6-storey steel frame glazed internal atrium.

APA Facade Systems worked in conjunction with Season Master Double Glazing to complete this project. Kevin Street Garda Station has a magnificent design with a curved street elevation along the east boundary. This curved elevation was glazed using our TB50, TB50 SG, TB50 CFV's and and TB50 30-minute fireproof systems were installed on this building.


