



The UCD Moore Centre for Business, the new wing of the UCD Lochlann Quinn School at the UCD Belfield campus, officially opened on the 2nd of September 2019.

Duggan Brothers built a substantial extension that incorporates an additional lecture theatre with learning areas, collaboration workspaces, classrooms, huddle/meeting rooms, studios, booths, an extension to the existing café/lounge and all ancillary areas. The new 2,996 m<sup>2</sup> building is a key element of the UCD college of business' €65M strategic plan to be among the worlds top 50 business schools by 2020.
